1 Overview

2 Venue Information

- 2.1 There is free car parking for 150 cars. There is no need to pre-book.

- 2.4 The nearest overground station can be found at Charlton and is a six-minute walk away from the venue.
- 2.5 The nearest underground stations are Woolwich or Woolwich Arsenal but these are both at least a 30 minute walk from the venue. A number of bus routes serve the venue – 53, 54, 161, 177, 180, 422, 472, 486. They stop in Charlton Village or on the A206 Woolwich Road, both a five-minute walk away.
