1 Overview

- 1.1 The first AMIP meeting of 2023 will be held on Wednesday 8 March 2023 between 10:00 and 17:00, with refreshments and networking from 09:30.
- 1.2 Delegates will be able to enter after 08:45 through the staff gate which is on the **<u>right-hand</u>** side of the main entrance and Gift Shop.
- 1.3 As HMS Belfast does not open to the public until 10:00, the Security Team will be given the list of all delegates and will only allow access to those delegates named on the list.
- 1.4 The focus of the meeting will be on Equality, Diversity and Inclusion (EDI) as well as respect within the housing sector and will explore how organisations can encourage an inclusive and supportive culture in their workplaces.
- 1.5 Delegates will be able to explore all nine decks of the warship during the day during all breaks. There will also be a private lunchtime talk from one of only 17 Yeoman from HMS Belfast.
